Interconnector Project – Dive Survey, Chilling**

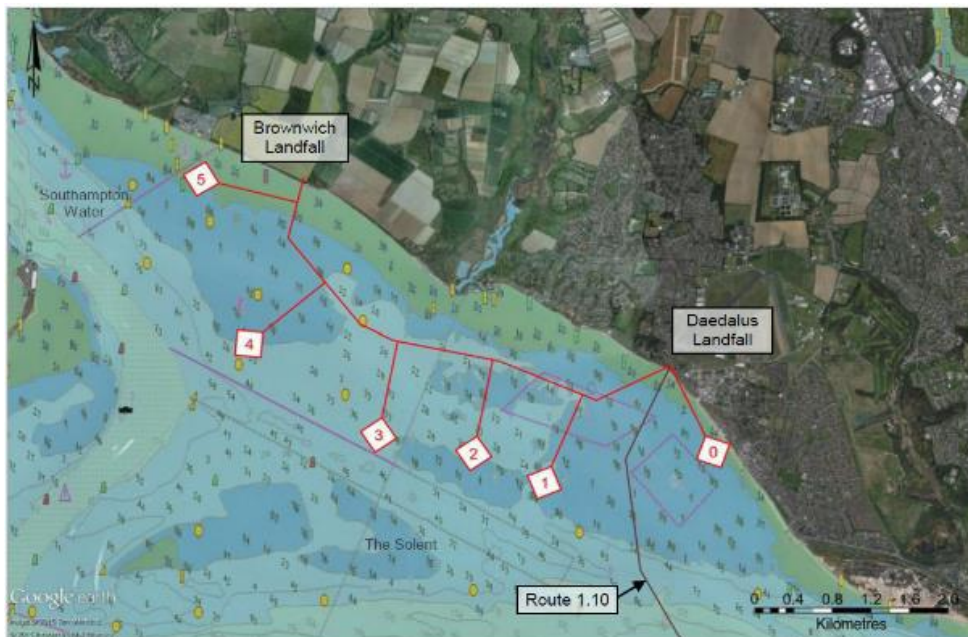

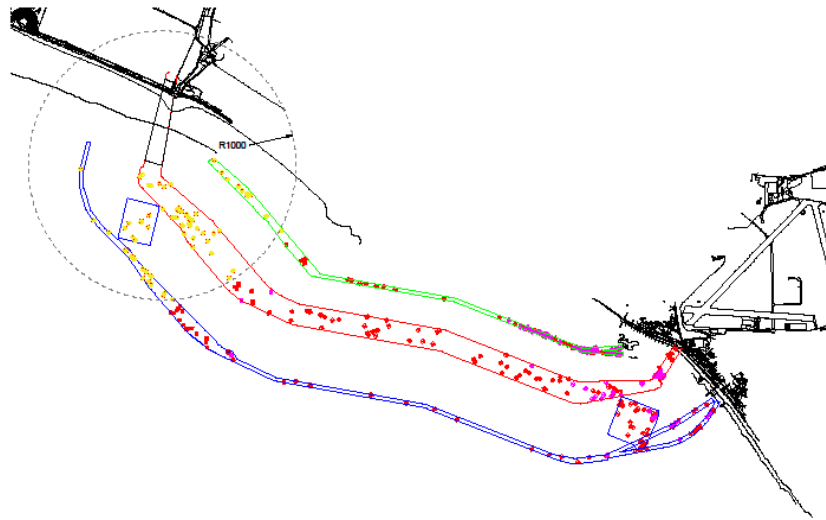
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Dive Survey works are due to commence today, 19th June with expected completion in approximately 42 days, finishing on 31st July for the IFA2 project, a HVDC electricity transmission between France and England across the English Channel.

The location of the dive sites for this operation are in an isolated nearshore area at Chilling on the HVAC route, see below diagram for details.

The Dive works are being carried out by **James Fisher Marine Service** using **HM Denham**, Call Sign 2ATJ3, **Chartwell**, Call Sign MHGV6 and **Avon**, Call Sign GZZA for the works, The diving operations will be located at the Chilling to Daedalus area where a dive support vessel will be stationed. Works are planned to begin at the western Chilling end and then progress east towards Daedalus.

Overview of the Diving working area:





Vessels are requested to pass at a safe speed and distance and fishing vessels are advised to remain a safe distance (approximately 100m) from the areas identified. The vessel will not be towing equipment and will remain stationary during the majority work scope.

This notice will be self-cancelling on completion of the survey operations.
