

## **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

**No 25 (T) of 2018**

**Port of Southampton – River Test – Mayflower Park**  
**Seawork International 2018**  
**3<sup>rd</sup> July to 5<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Seawork 2018 International Commercial Marine Exhibition & Conference will take place at Mayflower Park, Southampton, between 3<sup>rd</sup> July and 5<sup>th</sup> July 2018. Seawork 2018 is using a segment of the Southampton Boat Show pontoon footprint.

During Seawork more than 50 craft of up to 40 metres LOA (length overall) will be berthed on the pontoons. It is expected that craft will arrive on site from Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> July and are expected to have left the site by midday on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July.

Mariners passing Mayflower Park during the Exhibition should do so at slow speed, consistent with safe navigation, and should avoid creating undue wash. Mariners should also be alert to the fact that members of the public will be on the pontoons during the Exhibition.

Exhibitors have been given dispensation to demonstrate their craft, at speed if necessary, in the Hovercraft Testing Area off Weston shore and in the Marchwood Channel area but, elsewhere in the immediate port area, are to comply with the speed limit of 6 knots. Additionally, shore-based and pontoon-based demonstrations will take place during the Exhibition but will remain within the confines of the pontoons themselves. Notwithstanding, mariners are to follow the advice of Southampton VTS in keeping clear of any demonstrations in the pontoon area.

On completion of Seawork 2018, 'Walcon Wizard' will continue works on the installation of

piles and pontoons off Mayflower Park, in preparation for the Southampton Boat Show 2018.

This notice will be self-cancelling on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2018.
