

NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 46 (T) of 2018

Port of Southampton – Silt Removal – Marchwood Yacht Club – October 2018

Notice is hereby given that 500m³ of silt from Marchwood Yacht Club (Inner Pontoon area) will be removed to the Hurst Spoil Grounds by the BP Norse Marine hopper barge, VR49. The hopper barge will be towed by the tug Storebror, call sign ZNEC3. There will be no depth or manoeuvrability restrictions to the operating vessels.

The works will be carried out from 8th October to 19th October 2018.

The hopper barge and tug will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and mariners are requested to reduce speed as safe navigation permits when passing them whilst engaged in underwater activities.

The works vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout the clearance operations and mariners may also request movement information from Southampton VTS on VHF Channel 12.

This notice will be self-cancelling on 20th October.
