

NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 24 (T) of 2020

Port of Southampton – Reporting and quarantine requirements for recreational arrivals from outside of the United Kingdom

At the request of the Home Office, mariners' attention is drawn to following requirements on those arriving at a UK port on recreational vessels from overseas.

There is a UK wide requirement for all international arrivals, including those on yachts, other than those travelling from the Republic of Ireland, Channel Islands and Isle of Man (the Common Travel Area/CTA), to complete a mandatory digital health contact form and (unless exempt) to quarantine for 14 days after their arrival.
