

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Maintenance Dredging Ocean Village Marina and Hythe Marina Approach November 2017 to February 2018

Notice is hereby given that maintenance dredging works will take place in Ocean Village Marina and Hythe Marina approach channel.

The works will commence on or about Saturday 11th November 2017 in Ocean Village Marina followed by Hythe Marina approach channel in early February 2018.

The backhoe dredging works will be conducted by the spud leg dredger 'WITTON II' and the hopper barges 'SPLIT TWO and SPLIT THREE' will carry the spoil to the Nab disposal ground.

All craft will display the lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and both dredger and hopper barges will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout.

Mariners are requested to reduce speed, as safe navigation permits, when passing 'WITTON II' when engaged in underwater activities.

This Notice will be self-cancelling on completion of the dredging operations.
