DPW Southampton – (Dubai Ports World) Container Terminal, Backhoe Dredging Programme

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Backhoe dredger 'ODIN' will be engaged in dredging the Tug Shelf at Dubai Ports World (Southampton) (DPW(S)) Container Terminal for a period of approximately 5 weeks, commencing on or after 15th January 2022. Dredging operations will be continuous throughout the period.



'ODIN' will load four non-propelled Split Hopper Barges which will then be towed/pushed to the NAB/Hurst disposal site.

Vessels Involved

Backhoe Dredger 'Odin'

Tug's 'DUTCHESS' - 'AFON WEN' - 'TERRANMARE 1' - 'DUKE OF NORMANDY' & 'WILLPOWER'

Survey Vessels 'PORTHOS' & 'CORAL WIND'

Split Hopper Barges 'B1001' - 'B1002' - 'TERRAFARE 1' & 'TERRAFARE 2'

Mariners should expect to pass these vessels at any time between the upper reaches of the River Test, Southampton Water, Nab disposal area and the Hurst Disposal area.

All vessels will display the lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (ColRegs) and mariners are requested to reduce speed, as safe navigation permits, when passing the vessel whilst engaged in dredging or loading activities.

All vessels involved will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout the operations & VHF Channel 87 within the DPW working area, and mariners may also request movement information from Southampton VTS on VHF Channel 12.
