


## NOTICE TO MARINERS No 63 (T) of 2023 Port of Southampton

## **UXO** and Archaeological investigations

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that commencing the 4<sup>th</sup> of October 2023 the workboat "**WILLSUPPLY**" and **RS divers** will be on site conducting diving investigation works for UXO and Archeology. This will take place between the Dibden bay cardinal and Swinging ground No.8, estimated completion will be on or around the 1<sup>st</sup> of December 2023. The area of works is

highlighted in the image below.



Weather permitting, these operations will be day working throughout the stated period and mariners should expect to pass "WILLSUPPLY" at any time in the area highlighted above.

The workboat and associated tenders will display Flags, lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and mariners are requested to reduce speed and give a wide berth as safe navigation permits when passing the vessel engaged in diving activities.

The workboat will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout diving operations and mariners may also request information from Southampton VTS on VHF Channel 12.
